The World Affairs Council of Charlotte (WACC) will host its annual Academic WorldQuest competition on Wednesday, November 8 at the Hilton Charlotte Center City. Teams from 25 high schools from the greater Charlotte area will participate in this international trivia competition and answer questions related to current events, history, geography and other topics of global significance.

For the eight consecutive year, these high school students will play alongside business and individual groups that will compete in WorldQuest, the community version of this global knowledge competition. Recognized as the largest international education program of its kind in North Carolina, Academic WorldQuest and WorldQuest will bring together approximately 600 students and community members in friendly competition.

Proceeds from WQ2017 will benefit the following education outreach initiatives:

Academic WorldQuest

ENABLES teams from public and independent high schools in the greater Charlotte region to compete in this international knowledge competition. Categories include world history, flags, foreign policy, geography and current events.

• Council Scholar Award Program

GIVES grants of up to \$2500 allow teachers to study abroad or participate in professional development opportunities overseas.

• Global Ambassador Program

SIMPLIFIES access for high school students from Charlotte-area schools to attend WACC programs and listen to world-renowned experts discuss pertinent global issues affecting the world today.

• Euro Challenge

EVALUATES high school students in North Carolina on their knowledge and understanding of the European economy and the euro, the currency shared by many of the 28 countries of the European Union. Student teams create presentations that explore real world economic problems and allow students the opportunity to step into the shoes of international policy makers by constructing recommendations and solutions.

• Young Explorers Essay Competition

PROMOTES core competencies in research and analysis and composition with a global-issue focused topic for middle school students in Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools.

• Speaker in the Classroom

FACILITATES round-table discussions or classroom presentations led by international experts visiting Charlotte.

• International Career Panel

OFFERS college graduates (or seniors) and early-career professionals the opportunity to listen to, and network with mid-career professionals who offer valuable advice on job entry in the fields of international business, law, non-profit, government and international education.

• Higher Education Institution Partnerships

ENABLES partnerships with local higher education institutions for International Education Week and the International Speaker Series Program.
