H.E. Mariangela Zappia, Ambassador of Italy to the United States

Mariangela Zappia is the Italian Ambassador to the United States of America. A career diplomat with over thirty-five years of experience, she is the first woman in her country to hold this position, as she was the first woman Permanent Representative of Italy to the United Nations in New York and to the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO). She has also been the first woman Diplomatic Advisor to the Italian Prime Minister and G7/G20 Sherpa.

She holds a Master degree in Political Science and International Relations from the University of Florence and a Post-graduate degree in Diplomatic and International Relations from the same University. She has followed periodic high-level training courses on diplomatic practice and management at the Diplomatic Academy of the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Rome.

She speaks fluent English and French, and has a good knowledge of Spanish.

She has been awarded the decoration of "Commendatore" (Commander) of the Order of Merit of the Italian Republic.

She is an active member of the International Gender Champions Network aimed at promoting gender parity and women's participation in decision-making. In 2019 she was awarded with the "Mela d'Oro" (Golden Apple) by the "Fondazione Marisa Bellisario" in recognition of her contribution to the advancement of women in public institutions.

She's the mother of Claire, 28, and Christian, 24.
