Ambassador Santiago Cabanas was born in Madrid in 1954. He holds a Law Degree from the Autonomous University of Madrid and joined the Spanish Foreign Service in 1981.

The Ambassador was most recently Ambassador to Algeria, where he started his mission in 2017. Prior, he held top-ranking positions at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Spain, including Director of the Minister's Cabinet and Director General for Foreign Policy.
