Asha is a Council on Foreign Relations term member, Senior Fellow at the Diplomat Courier, and a member of National Security Leaders for America, a non-partisan network of former military and civilian leaders from across the political spectrum uniquely qualified to provide expert insight on U.S. national security and its impact on democracy and economic stability. A recipient of numerous honors, including the Middle East Policy Council 40 Under 40, she is frequently featured in major media outlets such as CNN, Fox News, BBC News and *The Washington Post*.
